



## Plea not to travel

The number of infections in Heilbronn is still very high. In order to reduce the numbers and not overburden our health system, we urgently request that you comply with the current regulations of the Coronavirus Ordinance. Please also reduce your personal contacts and follow the general rules: According to Germany's 'AHA-formula' (Abstand halten, Hygiene beachten, Alltagsmaske tragen \*\*In English "maintain a distance from others, take hygiene measures, and wear a face mask"). Protect yourself and others.

We urge you: not to travel during the Christmas holidays, even if you have planned visits and your family time is very important.

If you return to Germany from a high-risk area, you must immediately go into quarantine for a period of 10 days. This means that you are not allowed to leave your apartment or house during this time and you are not allowed to receive any visits. In addition, you are not entitled to your remuneration/salary from your employer during quarantine. If the Corona Ordinances are violated, fines of several thousands of euros may be imposed.
